Gus & Paulette Gamba, Gamba Vineyards

With over 75 years of experience cultivating wine grapes in the Russian River Valley, and seven generations dedicated to winemaking, the Gamba family represents a significant chapter in Sonoma County California's viticultural history. The family's long-standing tradition of wine growing traces its ancestral origins over the last three centuries originating in Northern Italy.

Agostino "Gus" Gamba began his journey as a winemaker through a structured apprenticeship under his father's guidance, working from an early age in the family's historic, century-old Zinfandel vineyard located in the Russian River Valley of Sonoma County. Gus' training by his father initially focused on vine cultivation before transitioning to the intricacies of artisan winemaking. He later assumed management of the Gamba Estate Vineyard with the intention of establishing a family-operated winery.

Gus pursued higher education at the University of California at Santa Barbara, followed by studies in Viticulture and Enology at UC Davis. His career began with several premier Sonoma County wineries. In 2000, Gus and his wife Paulette founded Gamba Vineyards and Winery.

Gamba Vineyards and Winery has enjoyed recognition and numerous accolades throughout the years. Robert Parker Jr. of the Wine Advocate consistently awarded critical acclaim to Gamba Zinfandels, describing them as "Among the best..." and recognizing Gamba as one of the "...Stars of Sonoma." Jim Gordon's definitive wine atlas, Opus Vino, notes: "Gamba Zinfandels are highly sought after... as one of the best in Sonoma County."

Today, with the entry of the seventh generation, the business remains family owned and operated, upholding the principle that exceptional wines originate in the vineyard.
